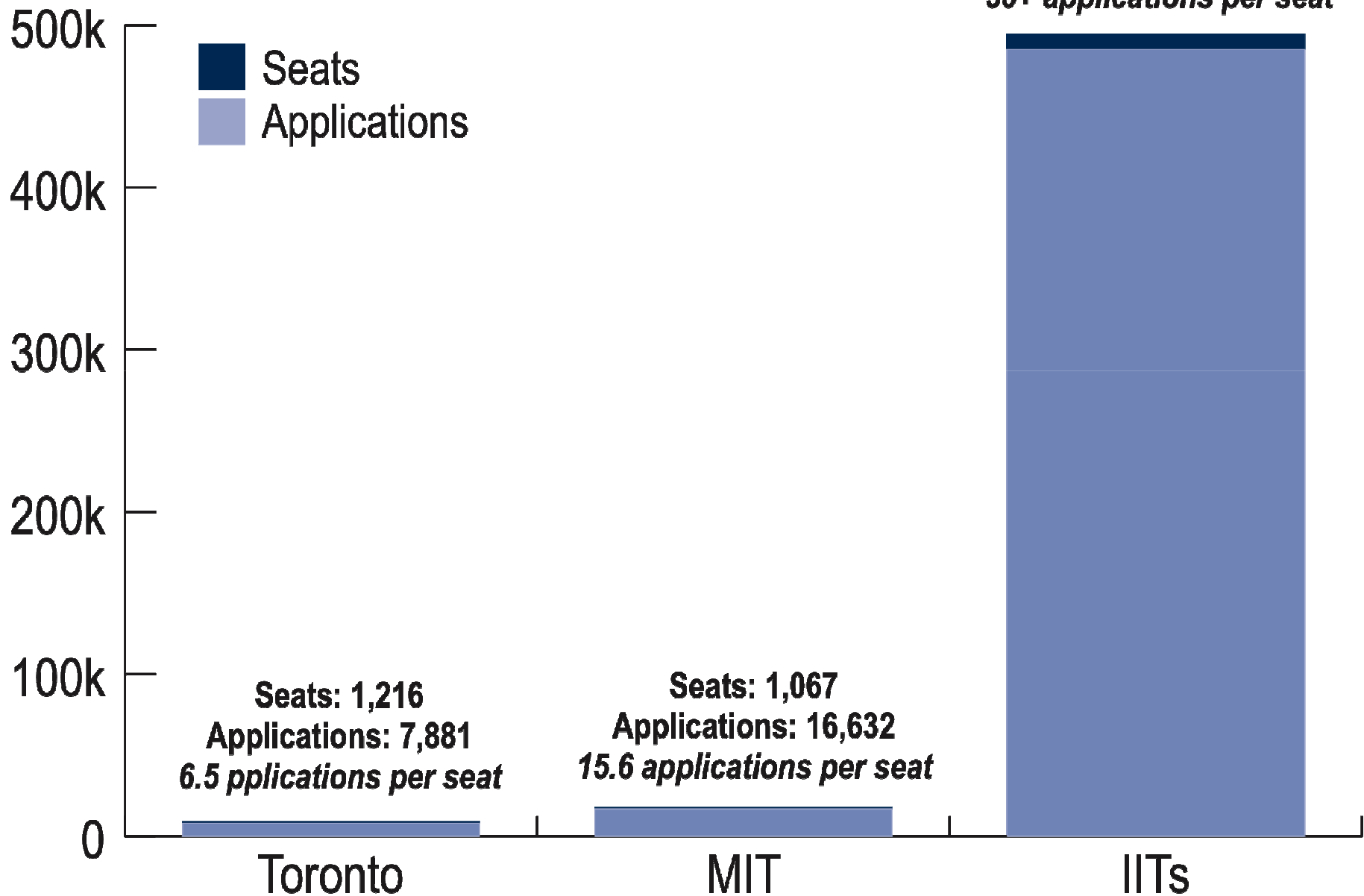

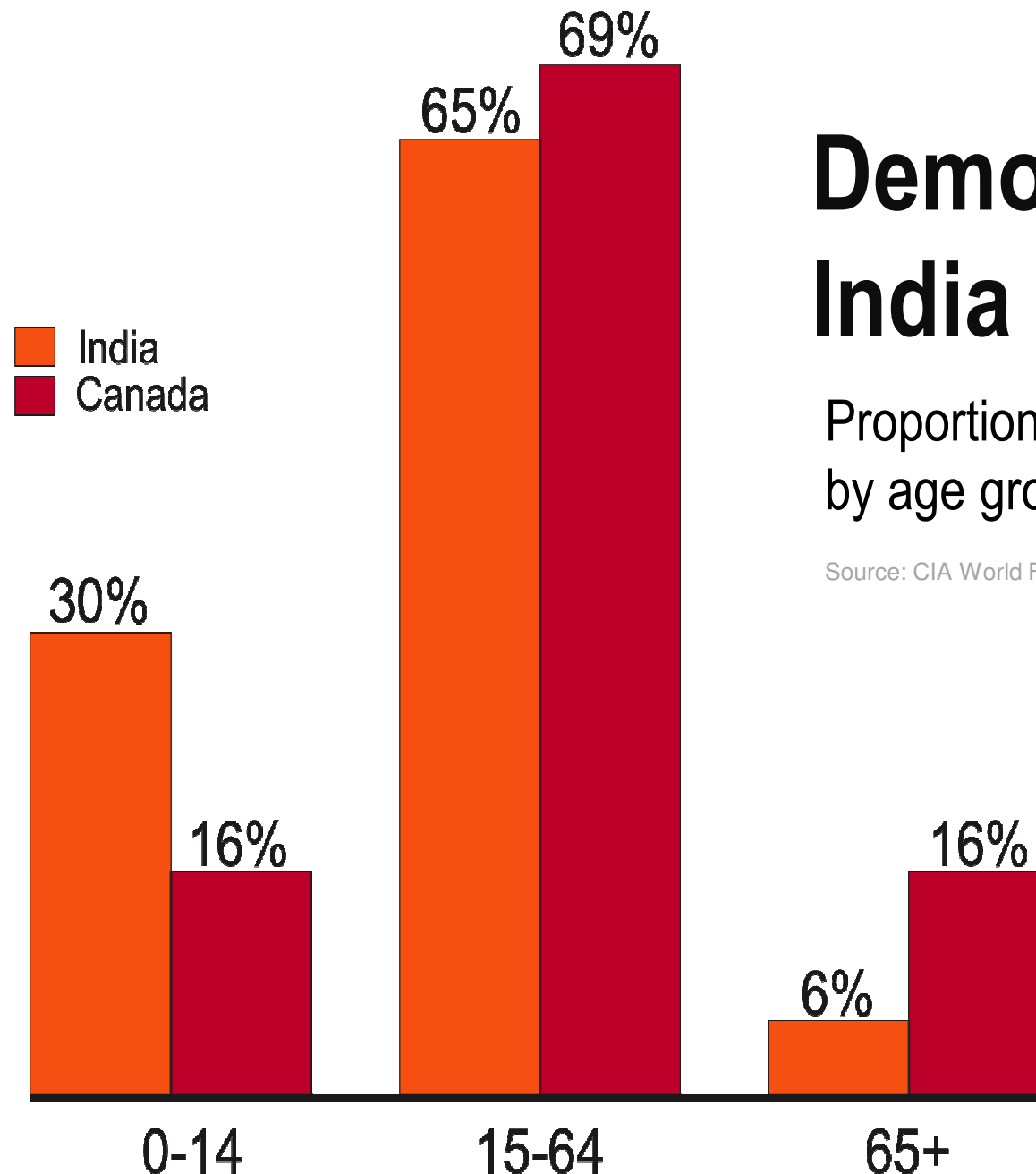

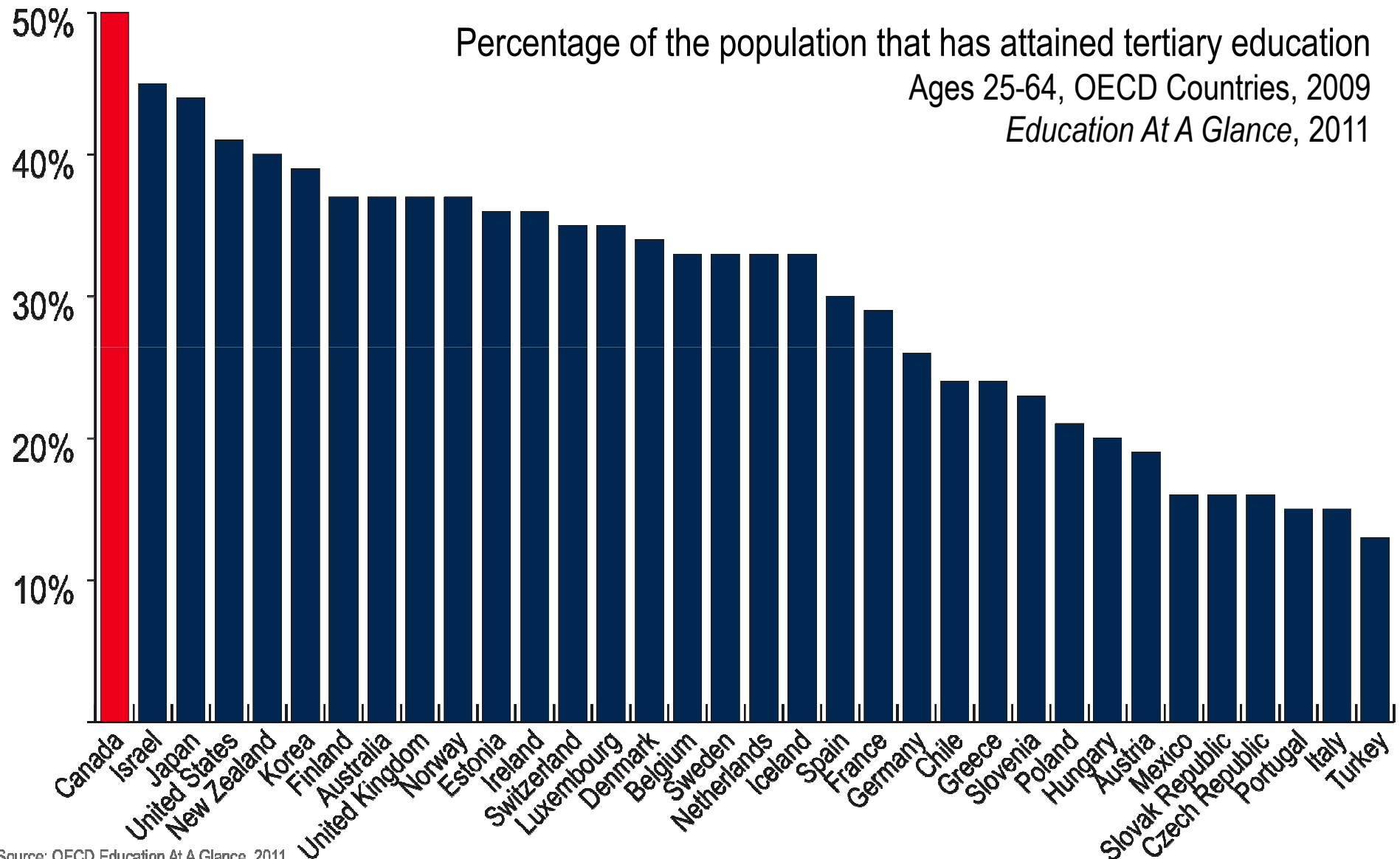

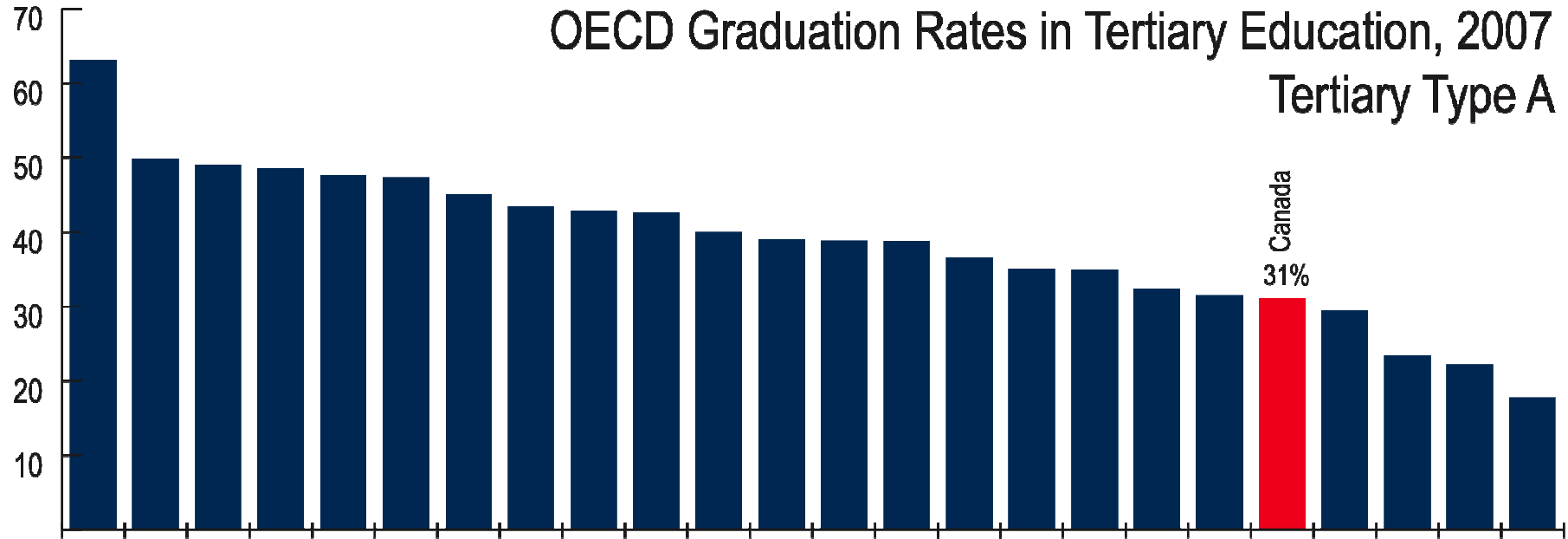




Tertiary Educated Population
