Dr Daniel C Levy is a Distinguished Professor, SUNY and is currently the Director, Program for Research on Private Higher Education, University at Albany, SUNY (State University of New York).

Prior to this he was the Professor of Educational Administration & Policy Studies at the University of Albany; Joint appointment in Latin American Studies and affiliated appointment in Political Science. He is also a member of the Public Policy Program. He has Research affiliations at Yale and several Latin American universities and was a Research Associate at Yale University in early part of his career.

He was an Associate for the Study of Higher Education and Director, Task Force on Higher Education, Latin American Studies Association. He has been a Senior Mentor, Ford Foundation Latin American Higher Education Fellows Program, Harvard University. He has served on numerous journal and advisory boards. He was named Collins Fellow, the University at Albany's highest faculty title for collegial service. He has been a consultant or guest to various organizations and has presented numerous lectures and papers. He has received various awards and honors for his work in higher education. He has also authored various books, the latest being, 'The Global Growth of Private Higher Education', co-author with Kevin Kinser et al. ASHE, 2010.
