Prof David Naylor has been the President of the University of Toronto since 2005. Prior to this he was the Dean of Medicine and Vice Provost for Relations with Health Care Institutions after being the founding Chief Executive Officer of the Institute for Clinical Evaluative Sciences of the University of Toronto. He joined the Department of Medicine of the University of Toronto after completing clinical specialty training.

He has co-authored approximately 300 scholarly publications, spanning social history, public policy, epidemiology and biostatistics, and health economics, as well as clinical and health services research in most fields of medicine. Among other honours, he is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, a Foreign Associate Fellow of the US Institute of Medicine, and an Officer of the Order of Canada.

He earned his MD at Toronto, followed by a D Phil at Oxford where he studied as a Rhodes Scholar.
